NO. 070825-0000) (THE "PROPERTY") THEREBY 17 ENABLING THE GRANTEE TO SELL THE PROPERTY TO A 18 THIRD PARTY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 19

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WHEREAS, the Property is subject to a right of reverter created pursuant to Ordinance 1995-504-274 (the "1995 Ordinance") as set forth in that certain Special Warranty Deed recorded at Official Records Book 8240, Page 889 of the Public Records of Duval County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the 1995 Ordinance, the Property was declared surplus and conveyed for no consideration to Grantee, who then owned and utilized the adjoining northern parcel (the "Northern Parcel") as a nationally recognized manuscript museum, with the condition that the Property could revert to the City if no longer utilized and maintained by Grantee; and

WHEREAS, the manuscript museum has now permanently closed and Grantee desires to sell the Property and the Northern Parcel to a third party; and

WHEREAS, passage of this Ordinance by the Council will restate the City's right of reverter in the Property and clarify that the obligation to utilize or maintain the Property transfers to the successors and assigns of Grantee owning the Northern Parcel, thereby enabling Grantee to sell the property to a third party in its sole discretion for the purpose of promoting commercial infill development adjacent to downtown; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Approval and authorization. 12 Section 1. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation 13 14 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver to Grantee on behalf of the City, that certain Special Warranty Deed 15 in substantially the form attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled 16 as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev Deed, March 6, 2023 - NCSPHS" and all such 17 other documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purpose 18 19 of this Ordinance for the purpose of restating and clarifying the 20 City's existing right of reverter in and to the Property and enabling 21 the Grantee to sell the property to a third party buyer for the public 22 purpose of promoting commercial infill development adjacent to 23 downtown.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
