Bill Summary: The bill provides the City's recommendations to the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (NFTPO) for priority projects for the TPO's 2023 List of Priority Projects.

Background Information: The NFTPO is the transportation planning agency for the 4-county Northeast Florida region and is responsible for annually prioritizing projects in the region for which federal transportation funding is being sought. Project funding comes from a variety of use-specific federal and state funds and is shared among the 4 counties of the Northeast Florida region (Clay, St. Johns, Nassau, Jacksonville) on a proportional basis according to population. Jacksonville's list contains a total of 60 projects. The number of projects by category is as follows:

- Roadway Capacity Improvements: 13 projects (2 new)
- Tie-in to Resurfacing Projects: 2 projects
- Bridge Projects: 16 projects (all new)
- Sun Trails Projects: 3 projects
- FDOT/TAP Projects: 26 projects (24 new)

Policy Impact Area: Transportation improvements

Fiscal Impact: Jacksonville receives 56% of available regional funding based on its population share, a total of \$248,317,156 from various state and federal sources for FY23-24.
