6 Section 2. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this 7 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2023-8 2024.

9 Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 10 Section 1 is to transfer \$445,650.82 to the Information Technologies Specialized Equipment account to allow the City to continue its 11 Enterprise Security Video Camera Solution. The funds will be used 12 to purchase upgraded camera technology equipment, to replace non-13 14 functioning camera equipment (including network infrastructure), and to install/upgrade security-related hardware. These funds were 15 unencumbered at the end of fiscal year 2021-2022 after unintentionally 16 being omitted from Schedule AF "Capital Outlay Expenditures Not 17 Lapsed" in Ordinance 2022-504-E. Any funds remaining unspent at the 18 19 end of this fiscal year will be listed on Schedule AF in the proposed 20 fiscal year 2023-2024 budget.

21 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 23 without the Mayor's signature.
