AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$62,814,968 FROM THE DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND TO FUND THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MEDICAL EXAMINER FACILITY 04 PROJECT (THE "PROJECT"), AND AUTHORIZE BORROWING FROM THE CITY'S COMMERCIAL PAPER FACILITY AND/OR ISSUANCE OF FIXED-RATE DEBT IN THE CUMULATIVE, NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$62,814,968 AND APPROPRIATION THEREOF TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE PROJECT, AS BY B.T. 23-075; PURPOSE INITITATED APPROPRIATION; AMENDING 2022-504-E, THE FY 2022 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TO REPLACE FIFTH REVISED SCHEDULE B4, THE FY 2022-2023 DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND DETAIL, AND SECOND REVISED SCHEDULE B4b, THE FY 2022-2023 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS FUNDED VIA BORROWING, TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING AND/OR THE ISSUANCE OF FIXED-RATE DEBT FOR THE PROJECT; AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-E; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; REQUESTING ONE-CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the existing District 4 Medical Examiner's Office has outgrown its current building, which was originally constructed in 1968, and the City has previously authorized the construction of a new District 4 Medical Examiner's Office through the City's Capital

Improvement Plan ("CIP"), with current available, appropriated funds to date of \$26,000,000; and

WHEREAS, this legislation amends the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan project entitled "Medical Examiner Facility 04" project (the "Project") by eliminating FY24 and FY25 CIP appropriations and authorizing an additional appropriation in the current fiscal year of \$62,814,968, so that the Project may commence in May of 2023, which amount includes additional funding due to higher than anticipated construction costs; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals above are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account (s) listed in subsection (b): (B.T. 23-075 attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference)

- (c) Explanation of Appropriation: The funding above is an appropriation of \$62,814,968 to fully fund the Project.
- Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2 is to authorize an additional \$62,814,968 in current fiscal year funding to the Project to accelerate its completion date.
- Section 4. Amending 2022-504-E, the FY 2022-2023 Budget Ordinance, to replace Fifth Revised Schedule B4 and Second Revised Schedule B4b to provide additional funding for the Medical Examiner Facility 04 Project. 2022-504-E, the FY 2022-2023 Budget Ordinance, is hereby amended to replace Fifth Revised Schedule B4, entitled "FY

22-23 Capital Improvement Projects Funded via Borrowing", and Second Revised Schedule B4b, entitled "FY 22-23 Capital Improvement Projects Funded via Borrowing", to provide an additional \$62,814,968 in funding to the Project in the current fiscal year. The Sixth Revised Schedule B4 and Third Revised Schedule B4b are attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**.

Section 5. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the Project more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will delay completion of the Project and the existing facility is overburdened.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 6. Authorizing the Borrowing and Appropriation of Funds. The City is hereby authorized to borrow under its Commercial Paper Program and/or issue fixed-rate debt in the maximum amount of \$62,814,968 and such funds are hereby appropriated to fund the Project. The authorization set forth in this Section is subject to the requirements and prerequisites of the Commercial Paper Program and/or bond programs.

Section 7. Oversight. The Public Works Department shall oversee the Project described herein.

Section 8. Requesting One-Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One-cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the existing facility is outdated and over-burdened and this legislation authorizes funding as necessary to commence construction of a new facility in the current fiscal year.

Section 9. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
