Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 13 Section 2. Section 1 is to provide funding for surveying, engineering, design, 14 plans preparation, permitting, and bidding for the Project. 15 The 16 Project entails closure of the McCoys Creek Boulevard right-of-way 17 to provide new open space for park improvements, including pedestrian/bike paths, green space, and creek restoration. A copy 18 19 of the Modification to Subgrant Agreement Between the Division of 20 Emergency Management and City of Jacksonville (Contract Number: 21 H0595) providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and 22 expenditure of the grant funds is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and 23 incorporated herein by this reference.

Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. 24 Section 3. Ordinance 25 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan 26 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is 27 hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the 28 Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet 29 attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this 30 reference. The City Council finds that deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be 31

detrimental to the best interests of the community because such
 deferral may result in loss of the grant funds.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

10 Section 4. Oversight. The Public Works Department 11 shall oversee the Project and administration of the grant described 12 herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
