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ORDINANCE 2023-147-E

AN ORDINANCE MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND AUTHORIZING A \$10,000,000 FUNDING CONTRIBUTION, SUBJECT TO FUTURE APPROPRIATION, TO SHANDS JACKSONVILLE MEDICAL CENTER, INC. ("SHANDS") TO SUPPORT THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE UF HEALTH JACKSONVILLE LEON L. HALEY, JR., MD, EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT AND TRAUMA CENTER (THE "HALEY CENTER"); AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO A FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE CAPITAL MAINTENANCE AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS COSTS DISBURSEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND SHANDS JACKSONVILLE MEDICAL CENTER, INC., PROVIDING FOR THE ADDITION OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE HALEY CENTER TO THE SCOPE OF WORK AND AN INCREASE TO THE MAXIMUM INDEBTEDNESS OF THE AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000,000, SUBJECT TO FUTURE APPROPRIATION, FOR A NEW TOTAL MAXIMUM INDEBTEDNESS OF \$105,000,000; PROVIDING FOR WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO DIRECT CONTRACT WITH SHANDS; CONTINUED OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City and Shands Jacksonville Medical Center, Inc.

("Shands") are parties to that certain Capital Maintenance and Capital Improvements Costs Disbursement Agreement dated March 20, 2019 (the "Agreement") whereby the City agreed to allow Shands to make certain capital improvements and capital repairs to City-owned land, buildings, and facilities over a six-year period in accordance with the terms of said Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Shands has requested, and the City has agreed, to amend the terms of the Agreement to include an additional scope of work for the construction of the UF Health Jacksonville Leon L. Haley Jr., MD, Emergency Department and Trauma Center (the "Haley Center") and to increase the maximum indebtedness by \$10,000,000 (to be used solely for construction of the Haley Center), subject to future appropriation, for a new total maximum indebtedness of \$105,000,000; and

WHEREAS, Shands has secured funding from other sources in the amount of \$80,000,000 for construction of the Haley Center and the \$10,000,000 in City funding may only be utilized after expenditure in full of all other funding; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Amendment to the Agreement with Shands Jacksonville Medical Center,
Inc. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and
Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver,
a Fifth Amendment to the Capital Maintenance and Capital Improvements
Costs Disbursement Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and
Shands Jacksonville Medical Center, Inc., in substantially the same
form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this
reference. The Fifth Amendment provides for the addition of a scope
of work for construction of the Haley Center and an increase to the

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maximum indebtedness of the agreement by \$10,000,000 (to be used solely for construction of the Haley Center), subject to future appropriation, for a new total maximum indebtedness of \$105,000,000.

Section 3. Waiver of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for execution of a Fifth Amendment to the Agreement as described above. This waiver is justified to allow the construction of the Haley Center on City-owned property with the intent that this stateof-the-art emergency department and trauma center will allow UF Health (Shands) to continue to lead the way in future advancements in adult and pediatric trauma care and to make this medical campus a hub for medical care, clinical research, innovation, and education in northeast Florida.

Section 4. Oversight. The Public Works Department shall continue to provide oversight of the Agreement and projects contemplated therein.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become Section 5. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
