Corner Lot Development Group (Corner Lot) is a leading real estate development firm with business
lines that include single-family, multi-family, urban and commercial development. Avion MF Partners,
LLC (Company) was by Corner Lot leaders.
The Company is proposing a 320-unit apartment community, with a mix of 1-, 2-, and 3-bedroom units located generally on Duval Road, north of I-295 and west of Biscayne Boulevard in Jacksonville, Florida. A total of 96 units, or 30 percent, will be set aside for workforce housing. The estimated hard costs associated with the Project is approximately \$65 million and the Company has committed to a minimum capital investment of \$58.5 million.
The City of Jacksonville proposes to provide a Recapture Enhanced Value (REV) based on 75 percent of the increase in real and personal property taxes generated at the project site, for 15 years, up to a maximum of \$7.5 million following substantial completion.
The project is not in a Targeted Industry and does not meet the requirement for a minimum of 10 new jobs to qualify for the REV Grant. Due to the project's large capital investment, proximity to a growing employment sector, and the City Council's stated desire for additional affordable housing, a waiver of the PIP is being requested.
