5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 685.104 (PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES FOR SEXUAL OFFENDERS AND 6 7 SEXUAL PREDATORS; EXCEPTIONS), CHAPTER 685 (SEXUAL 8 OFFENDER AND SEXUAL PREDATOR REGULATION), ORDINANCE CODE, TO PROHIBIT DISPLAY 9 OF HALLOWEEN DECORATIONS OR OTHER DISPLAYS OR 10 11 DECORATIONS AS DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDINANCE ON THE EXTERIOR OF ANY SEXUAL OFFENDER OR SEXUAL 12 13 PREDATOR RESIDENCE, VEHICLE OR VESSEL, OR ON ANY PROPERTY LEASED, RENTED, OWNED, OR OCCUPIED BY 14 15 A SEXUAL OFFENDER OR SEXUAL PREDATOR; PROVIDING CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING 16 AN 17 EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville supports doing anything 20 within its power to protect its citizenry, particularly children, 21 from becoming victimized by sexual offenders or sexual predators; 22 and

WHEREAS, sexual offenders and predators have been known to use certain holiday or seasonal events, decorations, and costumes to attract, entice, or lure children to areas in which those children are susceptible to attack by sexual offenders and predators; and

WHEREAS, the Council is concerned with the secondary effects of any speech or expressive conduct that entices, attracts, or lures children to vulnerable areas or circumstances as noted by, among other courts, the court in <u>Hobbs v. County of Westchester</u>, 397 F.3d 133 (2d Cir. 2005); and

1 WHEREAS, the following amendments to Chapter 685, Ordinance 2 Code, are suggested in order to provide clarity as to what displays 3 and decorations are prohibited so as to minimize or prevent attacks on children premised on decorations or costumes that attract, entice 4 5 or lure children into vulnerable areas or circumstances, while also conforming to First Amendment rights; recognizing, however, that 6 7 the amendments herein are intended to be inclusive as of the date of this enactment, but are not intended to include any and all 8 9 displays and decorations which were not contemplated at the time of 10 enactment(i.e., due to the advent of new technologies); now therefore 11

Section 1. Amending Section 685.104 (Prohibited Activities
for Sexual Offenders and Sexual Predators; Exceptions), Chapter 685

Section 685.104 (Prohibited Activities for Sexual Offenders and
Sexual Predators; Exceptions), Chapter 685 (Sexual Offender and
Sexual Predator Regulation), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to
read as follows:

CHAPTER 685 - SEXUAL OFFENDER AND SEXUAL PREDATOR REGULATION

Sec. 685.104. - Prohibited Activities for Sexual Offenders and Sexual
 Predators; Exceptions.

(a) Prohibitions and requirements for Sexual Offenders and Sexual Predators; Exemption.

(3) Any person designated a Sexual Offender or Sexual Predator shall:

29 (i) Avoid all Halloween related contact with children;
30 (ii) Not display or allow any display of Halloween
31 decorations to be visible from the exterior of any

1 Sexual Offender's or Sexual Predator's residence, including a vehicle or vessel, or an any property 2 3 which is leased, rented, owned, or occupied by such person from 6:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on October 31 (or 4 5 any other day on which Halloween is celebrated).From 6:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m., on October 31 (or any other 6 7 day on which Halloween is celebrated) post a sign at 8 his or her residence, including a vessel, or vehicle, 9 stating, "No candy or treats here." Such signs shall be in letters at least two inches high and shall be 10 11 legible on the property leased, rented, owned 12 occupied by the Sexual Offender or Sexual Predator, 13 and clearly visible from the street, waterway, or any property that is open to public access. The signs may 14 be removed after 11:59 p.m. on October 31, or the day 15 on which Halloween is celebrated. 16

(iii) Except for lighting provided on a year-round basis by the owner or manager of a multi-family residential unit for the purpose of security or walkway or hallway illumination, leave all outside residential lighting off during the evening hours after 5:00 p.m. on October 31 (or any other day on which Halloween is celebrated).

(iv) Not place or allow the following displays or decorations on the exterior of any Sexual Offender's or Sexual Predator's residence, including a vehicle or vessel, or on any property which is leased, rented, owned, or occupied by such person: inflatables, holograms, projections, displays over six feet in height, interactive displays, decorations or displays that include a fictitious character, decorations or

1	displays that line a walkway or path to a door of the
2	residence, or lights that are not affixed to the
3	residence, except there may be one lighted display
4	not affixed to the residence if it meets the
5	requirements listed here. Enforcement of this section
6	shall not be limited to the actual calendar date of

(45) Practices means to carry out or perform any particular 1 activity or method that may celebrate or recognize a 2 particular season, customs or beliefs. 3 (56) Non-familial children are is defined as those children 4 who are not related to the Sexual Offender or Sexual 5 Predator through biological means, marriage, or 6 7 adoption. 8 9 Section 2. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the 10 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth 11 herein. Such editorial changes and any other necessary changes to 12 make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation 13 are approved and directed herein, and the changes to the Ordinance 14 Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered. 15 Effective Date.
