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## ORDINANCE 2023-175-E

ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR ΑN DISCLAIMING AN OPENED AND IMPROVED PORTION OF THE WALNUT STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY, ESTABLISHED IN THE PLAT OF NEW SPRINGFIELD, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 2, PAGES 69 AND 70, OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7, AT THE REQUEST OF SETZER'S CORPORATION, WAREHOUSING INC., SUBJECT RESERVATION UNTO JEA OF AN ALL UTILITIES, FACILITIES AND ACCESS EASEMENT OVER THE CLOSURE AREA; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. An opened and improved portion of Walnut Street, established in the Plat of New Springfield, as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 69 and 70, of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 7, a depiction and description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as a right-of-way at the request of Setzer's Warehousing Corporation, Inc. (the "Applicant"); provided however, there is reserved unto JEA an all utilities, facilities and access easement on, over, under, through and across the closed right-of-way area for ingress and egress and for all utilities and facilities, including, but not limited to, water, sewer and electric, so as to provide JEA continued access to repair and maintain these

utilities and facilities.

The Applicant paid the right-of-way closure application fee of \$2,091.00 and the encroachment fee of \$516.00, for a total of \$2,607.00, and this sum has been deposited into the City's General Fund account. This closure request was reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the right-of-way and there were no objections to the Applicant's request.

Section 2. Purpose. The Applicant operates a commercial warehouse facility on the property surrounding the right-of-way closure area and has requested the closure in order to use the area for its business.

abandonment by the City of its interests in the right-of-way is subject to Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the right-of-way shall not be recorded in the public records until execution and delivery to the City by the Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
