ORDINANCE 2023-182-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN REAL ESTATE PURCHASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND JEFFREY AND KAREN RICKERT (THE "AGREEMENT"), AND ALL CLOSING AND OTHER DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO, AND TO OTHERWISE TAKE ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES OF THE AGREEMENT, FOR ACQUISITION BY THE CITY, AT THE NEGOTIATED PURCHASE PRICE OF \$110,000, OF AN APPROXIMATELY 0.10± ACRE PORTION OF THE PARCEL LOCATED AT 1460 STARRATT ROAD, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA (R.E. NO. 106330-0010) IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2, TO BE USED FOR COMPLETION OF THE STARRATT ROAD/DUNN CREEK ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT OF ACQUISITION OF THE PROPERTY BY THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THEREAFTER BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City, that certain Real Estate Purchase Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Jeffrey and Karen Rickert (the "Agreement")

in substantially the form attached hereto as ${\tt Exhibit}$ 1 incorporated herein by this reference, and all such other documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes of the Agreement and this Ordinance (with such technical changes as herein authorized). The Agreement provides for acquisition of an approximately 0.10± acre portion of the parcel located at 1460 Starratt Road, Jacksonville, Florida (R.E. No. 106330-0010), at the corner of Starratt Road and Dunn Creek Road, in Council District 2, as depicted on Exhibit 2 (the "Property"), to be used for completion of the Starratt Road/Dunn Creek Road Intersection Improvement Project (the "Project"). Property is the subject of a condemnation action filed by the City. The City's appraised value of the Property is \$21,900 and Mr. and Mrs. Rickert's (the "Sellers") appraised value is \$228,500. negotiated purchase price of \$110,000 was agreed upon between the parties through the mediation process with the City's purchase of the Property being contingent upon City Council approval of the purchase and the Mayor's execution of the Agreement.

The Agreement, and any and all closing and other documents related thereto, may include such additions, deletions, and changes as may be reasonable, necessary, and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification of the Agreement or related documents may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the financial obligations or liability of the Sellers, and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel. For purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City, including, but not
