Type of Action: Closing and abandoning right-of-way; reservation of utility and access easements

Bill Summary: The bill closes and abandons an unopened and unimproved right-of-way of Bettes Lane in the plat of Ortega and conveys the land to the adjacent property owner, reserving an all-utilities and access easement for JEA and AT&T.

Background Information: The owners of the property at 3764 Ortega Boulevard have applied for the closure of the unopened right-of way adjacent to their property in order to expand their yard and erect a fence. They have paid the closure fee of \$2,091. Easements are retained for JEA and AT&T for ingress and egress to access all utilities and facilities in the area being abandoned and the City is granted a hold-harmless agreement indemnifying the City against any liability.

Policy Impact Area: Right-of-way closure

Fiscal Impact: None to City; the applicants have paid the closure fee of \$2,091.
