Bill Summary: Per Ordinance 2014-700-E and section 189.02, *Florida Statutes*, the Millers Creek Dependent Special District must submit its proposed budget to the City Council every year by April 1st. This bill indicates that the District has submitted the proposed Fiscal Year 2023/2024 budget to the City Council by the deadline.

Background Information: The City of Jacksonville established the Millers Creek Dependent Special District for the purpose of dredging the Millers Creek canal system. The district raises revenue through homeowner assessments to reserve for dredging. The FY 2023-2024 Miller Creek District budget shows total projected revenue of \$80,730 (assessments \$3000 per homeowner on 29 properties) and total expenditures of \$80,708.76 with \$61.24 in reserves.
