AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 PAID TO THE 7 8 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE BY EAGLE LNG PARTNERS 9 JACKSONVILLE LLC ("EAGLE LNG") FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE 10 AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT IN AND AROUND THE EAGLE 11 LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS EXPORT TERMINAL 12 LNG 13 PROJECT SITE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-068; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS 14 15 AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO DESIGNEE, EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE 16 CITY, THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN 17 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND EAGLE LNG PARTNERS 18 JACKSONVILLE LLC; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE 19 20 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT; 21 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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23 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, 25 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 26 sum from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 27 listed in subsection (b):

This initial payment of funds will be used to purchase equipment for the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD) Urban Search and Rescue, Hazardous Materials, and Marine Specialty Teams.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 13 Section 1 is to receive revenue from Eagle LNG for the provision of 14 emergency services by JFRD in and around Eagle LNG's liquefied natural 15 gas export terminal project site located in the Port of Jacksonville 16 on the St. Johns River (the "Project"). Once completely built out, 17 the Project will occupy approximately 70.7± onshore acres and 11.1± 18 19 acres of submerged lands and will produce 1,650,000 gallons of 20 liquefied natural gas per day. Eagle LNG requires assistance from 21 JFRD for management of emergencies that may arise, including those 22 related to liquefied natural gas releases from containment or fires, 23 medical emergencies, security events, or other events that may require 24 firefighting, rescue, evacuation, or sheltering of the public. In exchange for these services, Eagle LNG has agreed to provide direct 25 26 financial support in the amount of \$100,000 per calendar year to JFRD 27 for sustainment of response personnel and equipment. No ongoing 28 equipment maintenance or additional staffing will be required to provide these services. 29

30 Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation 31

Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver for and on 1 behalf of the City, the Memorandum of Understanding between the City 2 of Jacksonville and Eagle LNG Partners Jacksonville LLC, in 3 substantially the same form attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, 4 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev MOU, April 17, 2023 - NCSPHS" and 5 incorporated herein by this reference, providing the terms and 6 7 conditions relative to JFRD's provision of emergency services at the Project site (the "Agreement"). The Agreement may include such 8 9 extensions, renewals, additions, deletions and changes as may be 10 reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with 11 such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the 12 Agreement by the Mayor or his designee; provided however, no 13 14 modifications to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or the liability of the City or decrease the duties and obligations 15 of Eagle LNG and any such modification shall be technical only and 16 shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the 17 Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the 18 term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no 19 20 financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes 21 that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement. 22

23 Section 4. Oversight. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
24 Department shall oversee the Agreement described herein.

25 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 27 without the Mayor's signature.
