## ORDINANCE 2023-212-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,600,000 FROM THE DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND, LONG TERM DEBT ISSUED ACCOUNT TO THE 2023 AUTHORIZED CAPITAL PROJECTS, CECIL WETLANDS - DM LAND ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE CECIL WETLANDS PROJECT AT THE CECIL MEGA SITE (THE "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 23-071; AMENDING ORDINANCE 2022-2022-2023 504-E, THE FISCAL YEAR ORDINANCE, TO REPLACE THE SIXTH REVISED SCHEDULE B4 TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR PROJECT; AMENDING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, Section 1. within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the account listed in subsection (b): (Revised B.T. 23-071, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 1, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev B.T. 23-071, April 17, 2023 - NCSPHS" and See Revised B.T. 23-071 \$5,600,000

(b) Appropriated to:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of a \$5,600,000 loan from the Debt Management Fund, Long Term Debt Issued account to the 2023 Authorized Capital Projects, Cecil Wetlands - DM Land account for the Cecil Wetlands Project at the Cecil Mega Site (the "Project").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the Project. The U.S. Army Corp of Engineers ("USACOE") previously issued permits to the City for remediation of wetland areas on the Cecil Commerce Center Mega Site and those permits are set to expire on September 22, 2023. Work is needed to fill and/or mitigate the subject wetlands prior to permit expiration. The cost of this work is estimated to be \$5,600,000. This appropriation will constitute a loan from the City's Debt Management Fund that will accrue interest beginning on the date it is funded. The loan will be repaid, in full, with accrued interest, upon the sale of the Mega Site land at Cecil Commerce Center or may be repaid sooner in the event the Cecil Commerce Center Trust Fund receives sufficient revenues from additional consideration payments, land sales, or other sources.

Section 3. Amending Ordinance 2022-504-E, the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget, to replace the Sixth Revised Schedule B4 to Reflect Funding for the Project. Ordinance 2022-504-E, adopting the 2022-2023 fiscal year budget, is hereby amended to replace the Sixth Revised Schedule B4, entitled "FY 22-23 Debt Management Fund Detail", to reflect funding for the Project as authorized herein. The Seventh Revised Schedule B4 is attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, 7th Rev Sched B4, April 17, 2023 - NCSPHS" and

incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
