5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,066,334 FROM THE
6 5TH STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO THE
7 JORK ROAD BRIDGE PROJECT TO COMPLETE
8 CONSTRUCTION OF A REPLACEMENT BRIDGE ON JORK
9 ROAD NEAR ATLANTIC BOULEVARD AND DEGROVE ROAD,
10 AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-081; AMENDING THE 2023-
11 2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED
12 BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-E TO REFLECT THIS
13 APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE 5TH STREET
14 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO THE JORK ROAD
15 BRIDGE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
19 within the City’s budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
21 listed in subsection (b):

23 by this reference)

28 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

29 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$1,066,334
30 from the 5th Street Bridge Replacement project to the Jork
31 Road Bridge project to complete construction of a

1 replacement bridge on Jork Road between Atlantic Boulevard
2 and Degrove Road.

3 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
4 Section 1 is to allocate funds from the 5th Street Bridge Replacement
5 project to the Jork Road Bridge project (the "Project"). The Project
6 will entail replacing the existing bridge with a new bridge and
7 opening up the waterway access currently restricted by existing bridge
8 construction. The 5th Street Bridge Replacement project has been
9 accepted into the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Local
10 Agency Program (LAP) and therefore requires less funding than
11 anticipated. The FDOT LAP will make other funding sources available
12 for completion of that project resulting in the funds appropriated
13 by this Ordinance being made available for reallocation to the Jork
14 Road Bridge project.

15 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
16 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
17 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
18 hereby amended to this reallocation of funds from the 5th Street
19 Bridge Replacement project to the Jork Road - Jork Road Bridge project
20 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached
21 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The
22 City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP
23 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to
24 the best interests of the community because such deferral will
25 unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

26 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
27 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
28 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
29 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
30 an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the
31 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E

1 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

2 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
3 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
4 without the Mayor's signature.
