The Project will entail replacing the existing bridge with a new bridge and 6 7 opening up the waterway access currently restricted by existing bridge 8 The 5th Street Bridge Replacement project has been construction. 9 accepted into the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Local 10 Agency Program (LAP) and therefore requires less funding than anticipated. The FDOT LAP will make other funding sources available 11 12 for completion of that project resulting in the funds appropriated 13 by this Ordinance being made available for reallocation to the Jork Road Bridge project. 14

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 15 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan 16 17 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to this reallocation of funds from the 5th Street 18 19 Bridge Replacement project to the Jork Road - Jork Road Bridge project 20 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached 21 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP 22 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to 23 24 the best interests of the community because such deferral will 25 unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E
