AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR DISCLAIMING AN OPENED AND UNIMPROVED PORTION OF THE BETTES LANE RIGHT-OF-WAY, ESTABLISHED IN THE PLAT OF ORTEGA SUBURB OF JACKSONVILLE FLA, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 3, PAGE 40 OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 14, AT THE REQUEST OF PATRICK MORTON EMMET AND MARGARET BARNETT EMMET, SUBJECT TO RESERVATION UNTO JEA AND AT&T OF AN ALL UTILITIES, FACILITIES AND ACCESS EASEMENT OVER THE CLOSURE AREA; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 19 20 Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. An opened and 21 unimproved portion of the Bettes Lane right-of-way, established in 22 the Plat of Ortega Suburb of Jacksonville Fla, as recorded in Plat 23 Book 3, page 40 of the current public records of Duval County, 24 Florida, located in Council District 14, a depiction and description 25 of which is attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled as "Revised 26 Exhibit 1, Rev Depiction and Description, May 2, 2023 - TEU" and 27 incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as a right-of-way at the request of Patrick Morton 28 29 Emmet and Margaret Barnett Emmet (collectively, the "Applicant"); 30 provided however, there is reserved unto JEA and AT&T an all 31 utilities, facilities and access easement on, over, under, through

and across the closed right-of-way area for ingress and egress and for all utilities and facilities, including, but not limited to, water, sewer, electric, and telecommunications, so as to provide JEA and AT&T continued access to repair and maintain these utilities and facilities.

6 The Applicant paid the right-of-way closure application fee of 7 \$2,091.00 and this sum has been deposited into the City's General 8 Fund account. This closure request was reviewed and approved by the 9 various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest 10 in the right-of-way and there were no objections to the Applicant's 11 request.

12 Section 2. Purpose. The Applicant owns property adjacent 13 to the closure area at 3764 Ortega Boulevard (R.E. No. 101346-0000). 14 The Applicant has requested the closure in order to expand their 15 residential yard and install a fence.

16 Section 3. Hold Harmless Covenant. The closure and abandonment by the City of its interests in the right-of-way is 17 subject to Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold 18 19 Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as 20 Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Covnt, May 2, 21 2023 - TEU" and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the right-of-way shall not be recorded 22 in the public records until execution and delivery to the City by the 23 24 Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

25 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 27 without the Mayor's signature.
