SULZBACHER CENTER FOR THE HOMELESS, INC. (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$135,000 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund to procure contractual services and to fund various crime prevention and law enforcement activities in accordance with the Ordinance Code and Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, as more specifically outlined herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide \$125,000 to procure contractual services from I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. ("Sulzbacher") for the continued operation of a jail diversion program for mentally ill offenders through the Mental Health Offender Program. In addition, \$10,000 will be donated to Florida FBI National Academy Associates, Inc. for its annual Re-trainer program which provides training and networking opportunities for its members and attendees. Certification from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office certifying this appropriation from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The statute provides that these funds may be used only for school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, drug abuse education, or drug

prevention programs, or such other law enforcement purposes the City Council, as the governing body of the City of Jacksonville, deems appropriate.

Amendment to the Services Contract with I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, that certain Fourth Amendment to Services Contract between the City of Jacksonville and I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc., in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference, to increase the maximum indebtedness of the agreement by \$125,000 and to attach a revised Exhibit B (Budget) to reflect this additional appropriation of funds, for the continued provision of services for the Mental Health Offender Program in accordance with the terms of the agreement.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for an amendment to the Services Contract between I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc., and the City of Jacksonville. amendment would increase the maximum indebtedness of the Services Contract by \$125,000 to provide additional funds for Sulzbacher's continued oversight and management of the jail diversion program for mentally ill offenders through the MHOP. This additional allocation of funds to the agreement with Sulzbacher is justified because Sulzbacher has successfully operated the jail diversion program since the inception of the MHOP as a nine-month pilot project.

Section 5. Oversight. The Grants and Contract Compliance

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Division shall oversee the contract described herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
