**Bill Summary:** This bill is an appropriation of \$23,880 from the Safety and Crime Reduction Contingency to

FAOD Grant & Contract Compliance – Financial and Administration.

**Background Information:** Ordinance 2022-690 appropriated \$350,880 to provide grant funds for nonprofit entities which do not typically qualify to participate in the Public Services Grant process, and that were recommended and approved by the Safety and Crime Reduction Commission as organizations to implement programs that may help reduce crime county wide. The purpose of this legislation is to reallocate unspent minigrant funding allocated to the Safety and Crime Reduction Commission to the Division of Grants and Contract Compliance.
