6 MOTOR POOL - VEHICLE REPLACEMENT FUND, DUVAL
7 COUNTY HEALTH DEPT - STATE ACCOUNT TO THE MOBILE
8 EQUIPMENT ACCOUNT TO PURCHASE THE AGAPE HEALTH
9 MOBILE UNIT TO ALLOW THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
10 HEALTH, DUVAL COUNTY, TO INCREASE HIV/AIDS
11 PATIENT CARE IN UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES IN
12 JACKSONVILLE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-087;
13 PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR
14 REVERTER OF FUNDS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
20 listed in subsection (b):

27 Explanation of Appropriation:
28 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$75,000.00
29 from the Motor Pool - Vehicle Replacement Fund, Duval
30 County Health Dept - State Account to the Mobile Equipment
31 Account to purchase the Agape Mobile Health Unit to allow

1 the Florida Department of Health, Duval County, to increase
2 HIV/AIDS patient care in underserved communities in
3 Jacksonville.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
5 Section 1 is to provide funds to the Florida Department of Health,
6 Duval County ("FDOH Duval"), to purchase a mobile medical unit to
7 improve access to medical care in underserved areas of the
8 Jacksonville community for those living with HIV/AIDS. The intent
9 is to reduce the spread of HIV and to reduce viral loads of those
10 living with HIV. This medical unit will become an extension of the
11 FDOH Duval's clinical operations and will serve clients at their
12 location.

13 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated by this
14 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2023-
15 2024.

16 **Section 4. Reverter.** Any funds remaining after purchase of
17 the mobile medical unit shall be returned to the account of origin.

18 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
20 without the Mayor's signature.
