5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$281,321.00,  
6 INCLUDING \$267,924.76 IN GRANT FUNDING AWARDED  
7 BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND  
8 THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY THROUGH  
9 THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 FIRE PREVENTION & SAFETY  
10 GRANT PROGRAM AND A \$13,396.24 CITY MATCH, TO  
11 PURCHASE A FIRE SAFETY HOUSE INTERACTIVE  
12 LEARNING CENTER TRAILER AND A FIRE DOG PUBLIC  
13 EDUCATION COSTUME, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-088;  
14 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND  
15 RESCUE DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS  
16 DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
22 listed in subsection (b):

30 The funding above represents an appropriation of  
31 \$281,321.00, including \$267,924.76 in grant funding

1 awarded by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and  
2 the Federal Emergency Management Agency through the Fiscal  
3 Year 2021 Fire Prevention & Safety Grant Program, and a  
4 \$13,396.24 City match. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue  
5 Department ("JFRD") will use the funds to purchase a Fire  
6 Safety House Interactive Learning Center Trailer and a Fire  
7 Dog Public Education Costume. The grant period of  
8 performance commences April 11, 2023, and ends April 10,  
9 2024.

10 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
11 Section 1 is to provide funding for the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue  
12 Department to purchase a Fire Safety House Interactive Learning Center  
13 Trailer with an interactive kitchen emergency training room feature  
14 and a Fire Dog Public Education Costume. These items will be used  
15 to enhance JFRD's public safety education program. A copy of the  
16 Fiscal Year 2021 Fire Prevention & Safety Grant Program Award Letter  
17 (Grant Number: EMW-2021-FP-00043), providing the terms and conditions  
18 relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds, has been  
19 placed **On File** with the Legislative Services Division.

20 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue  
21 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee  
22 administration of the grant described herein.

23 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
25 without the Mayor's signature.
