**Bill Summary:** This bill seeks to amend *Ordinance Code* Section 106.216, proposing an exception for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO). It would allow the Chief of Fleet Management to purchase SUVs and large sedans for JSO without the requirement for a special exception request.

**Background Information:** Currently, Ordinance Code Section 106.216 mandates that all city departments submit a special exception request when intending to purchase SUVs and large sedans. However, SUVs have increasingly become the standard patrol vehicle across the industry, and Chrysler remains the sole manufacturer of police pursuit sedans. Additionally, the City of Jacksonville's mechanics lack certification to maintain or repair Chrysler vehicles.
