Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Cultural Council's appointment of Sondra R. Fetner to the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, replacing Alarie Gibbs as a community representative, for a partial term ending December 31, 2023.

Background Information: The Cultural Service Grant Program Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 118, Part 6, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to recommend to the Cultural Council Board of Directors the organizations to be funded and the amount of the funding. Section 118.605, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the membership of the committee shall include seven individuals selected by the Cultural Council Board President, CSGP Committee chairperson, and three selected Cultural Council Board members, from a pool of nominations established through a community wide nomination process, and confirmed by the City Council.

Ms. Fetner is the Director of Placemaking at the Jessie Ball duPont Fund, and she previously worked as a consultant for DIA and as an attorney in the Office of General Counsel. She is a Riverside Avondale Preservation Board Member. Ms. Fetner holds a bachelor's degree and JD from the University of Florida, and a Master of Urban Planning from the University of Southern California. She resides in Duval County in council district 14.
