ORDINANCE 2023-371

ORDINANCE REGARDING THE CTTY COUNCIL'S Α STRATEGIC PLAN; AMENDING ORDINANCE 2023-149-E SETTING FORTH THE CITY COUNCIL'S 1, 3 AND 5 YEAR STRATEGIC PLAN BY REVISING THE YEAR-1 GOALS FOR THE 2023-2024 FISCAL YEAR TO REMOVE THE FUNDING REQUEST OF \$250,000 TO THE BEAVER ENTERPRISE CENTER IN ORDER TO SUBMIT ALTERNATIVE FUNDING REQUEST OF \$250,000 TO THE CITY'S PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS, TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES AND OTHER ROADWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of Section 106.110, Ordinance Code, the Council is required to update and adopt its strategic plan annually; and

WHEREAS, in preparation of discussion of the various goals and initiatives for the strategic plan, City Council Members were asked to review the prior year's strategic plan and to submit ideas for priorities covering 1-year, 3-year and 5-year time frames, and a number of topical ideas were submitted for consideration; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2023, the Finance Committee developed the final list of 1, 3 and 5-year goals for the strategic plan along with funding requests corresponding to the year-1 goals for submittal to City Administration for inclusion in the fiscal year 2023-2024 budget; and

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2023, the City Council enacted Ordinance 2023-149-E setting forth the Council's 1, 3 and 5-year goals and budgetary priorities for consideration by the Administration during the budget preparation process; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the Council's adoption of the strategic plan and submittal of its funding requests for the year-1 goals of the plan to Administration, Council Member Gaffney, Jr. was made aware of more pressing needs in Council District 7; and

WHEREAS, based on this most recent feedback from the community, Council Member Gaffney, Jr. proposes an amendment to the 1-year goals of the strategic plan for fiscal year 2023-2024 to delete the funding request of \$250,000 to the Beaver Street Enterprise Center in order to propose an alternative funding request of \$250,000 to the City's Public Works Department for installation of sidewalks, traffic calming devices, and other roadway safety improvements in Council District 7; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Ordinance 2023-149-E. Ordinance 2023-149-E is hereby amended to remove the funding request of \$250,000 to the Beaver Street Enterprise Center as outlined in the 1-year goals for 2023-2024 in order to submit an alternative funding request of \$250,000 to the City's Public Works Department for installation of sidewalks, traffic calming devices and other roadway safety improvements in Council District 7, as more specifically outlined in Exhibit 1 attached hereto.

Section 2. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the City Council would like to submit this revised funding request for the 1-year goals of the strategic plan to City Administration as quickly as possible for consideration for inclusion in the fiscal
