AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE 5 MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND 6 7 DELIVER, AN AMENDED AND RESTATED LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE 8 9 ("CITY") AND THE FLORIDA THEATRE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER, INC. ("TENANT"), WITH A CURRENT 10 FEBRUARY 12, 11 TERM EXPIRING 2035, AND AUTHORIZING ONE 25 YEAR EXTENSION OPTION, WITH 12 A SECOND, ADDITIONAL 24 YEAR EXTENSION OPTION, 13 FOR NOMINAL RENT; AMENDING SECTION 111.555, 14 (FLORIDA THEATRE MAINTENANCE TRUST FUND), PART 15 (PUBLIC WORKS, UTILITIES, 16 5 AND 17 INFRASTRUCTURE), CHAPTER 111 (SPECIAL REVENUE TRUST ACCOUNTS); PROVIDING FOR CITY 18 AND 19 OVERSIGHT BY THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION OF THE 20 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; REQUESTING ONE 21 CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN 22 EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amended and Restated Florida Theatre Lease Agreement approved and execution authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, that certain Amended and Restated Lease Agreement between the City of Jacksonville ("City") and The Florida Theatre Performing Arts Center, Inc. ("Tenant"), in substantially the same form placed On File with the Legislative Services Division. The Amendment to the Lease adds floors 4 - 7 of
the Office Building to the leased premises and clarifies
maintenance obligations.

Amending Section 111.555 (Florida 4 Section 2. Theatre 5 Maintenance Trust Fund), Part 5 (Public Works, Utilities, and Infrastructure), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue Trust Accounts). 6 7 Chapter 111 (Special Revenue Trust Accounts), Part 5 (Public Works, Utilities, and Infrastructure), Section 111.555 (Florida Theatre 8 9 Maintenance Trust Fund), is hereby amended to read as follows:

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CHAPTER. 111 Special Revenue and Trust Accounts

PART 5. Public Works, Utilities, and Infrastructure

Sec. 111.550 - Florida Theatre Maintenance Trust Fund.

14 There is hereby established a special fund within the City's accounts, to be known as the "Florida Theatre Maintenance Trust 15 Fund", into which shall deposit the rent collected net of expenses 16 17 for the rental of the Florida Theatre offices. The funds shall be 18 used exclusively to fund the maintenance and capital improvements 19 of the Florida Theatre portion of the building. Said funds may 20 either be utilized directly for the funding of maintenance, or 21 capital outlays, or used as a committed revenue source for the 22 bonding of the above-described costs. All sums placed into the fund 23 shall thereafter be appropriated by the City Council in accordance 24 with this section. Any undistributed funds shall not lapse at the close of any fiscal year, but instead shall carry over to the next 25 26 fiscal year.

27 Section 3. Oversight. The Real Estate Division of the 28 Department of Public Works shall oversee the project described 29 herein.

30Section 4.RequestingOneCycleEmergencyPassage31Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901Emergency.Oncecycleemergency

1 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the 2 emergency is to allow for continuity of lease terms and clarify 3 maintenance obligations in light of ongoing and upcoming schedule 4 capital improvements at Florida Theatre.

5 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 6 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 7 without the Mayor's signature.
