Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$481,750 from the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection for the Duval County 2022 Hurricane Ian and Nicole Recovery Project. The Department of Public Works, Engineering and Construction Management Division will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for beach and dune restoration from the north end of Hanna Park to the south end of Duval County, to mitigate beach and dune erosion sustained during Hurricanes Ian and Nicole. The funds will cover labor costs and the placement of fill material and/or construction of erosion control structures.

Policy Impact Area: Beach and dune restoration
