106.216 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION (REPLACEMENT OF FLEET VEHICLES), PART (BUDGETS), CHAPTER 106 (BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXCLUDE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT FROM THE REQUIREMENT Α SPECIAL EXCEPTION THAT ΒE REQUESTED AND APPROVED FOR AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE AN SUV OR LARGE SEDAN; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the needs of the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office pertaining to its fleet have evolved over the years; and

WHEREAS, a sedan was once the standard patrol vehicle for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office, but now the sport utility vehicle ("SUV") is becoming the standard patrol vehicle; and

WHEREAS, SUVs provide more space for transporting law enforcement officers' equipment (which has continued to increase over time), SUVs provide a higher ride height which allows for better visibility for officers to see over other vehicles and obstacles, and SUVS are more durable vehicles able to withstand high speed chases and rough terrain; and

WHEREAS, Chrysler is now the only manufacturer of a police pursuit sedan, and City of Jacksonville mechanics are not certified to maintain or repair Chrysler vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the needs of the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department pertaining to its fleet are ever evolving and require specialty vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department has operational needs that require maneuverability and off-road capability of a SUV when responding to wildfires and other off-road incidents; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department to transport certain prescriptions (controlled substances) and high-value equipment, SUVs provide a more secure interior space than a pick-up truck with a topper, which is part of Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department's current fleet; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance Code provision at issue, as it currently exists, has become obsolete as it pertains to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office and the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Section 106.216 (Replacement of Fleet Vehicles), Part 2 (Budgets), Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code), Ordinance Code. Section 106.216 (Replacement of Fleet Vehicles), Part 2 (Budgets), Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 106 - BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING CODE

PART 2. - BUDGETS

* * *

Sec. 106.216 - Replacement of Fleet Vehicles.

(e) The Chief of Fleet Management shall purchase vehicles according to the final list described herein as funds are budgeted for the same. With the exception of the

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Office of General Counsel

Jacksonville Sheriff's Office and the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department, noNo SUV or large sedans shall be authorized for purchase within the City Fleet, unless special exceptions have been requested in writing by the requested party and approved by the Chief of Fleet Management and the director of the Department, overseeing the Fleet Management Division. The Chief of Fleet Management shall provide a list of all special exceptions and written requests annually with the Fleet budget to City Council.

Section 2. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth herein. Such editorial changes and any other necessary to make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and the changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
