11 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

12 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
13 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
14 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
15 listed in subsection (b):

22 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

23 The funding above comprises \$87,575.00 in Air Pollution
24 Tag Fee fund balance to replace aging ambient air
25 monitoring analyzers.

26 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
27 Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase of four new ambient
28 air monitoring analyzers to replace existing devices operated and
29 maintained by the Neighborhoods Department, Environmental Quality
30 Division. These devices are used to monitor and report levels of air
31 pollutants in Duval County as required by the U.S. Environmental

1 Protection Agency (the "EPA"). There are multiple analyzers at seven
2 ambient air monitoring sites throughout the County and the EPA
3 requires these devices to be replaced every five to seven years.

4 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
