7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$75,000.00 FROM THE
8 MOTOR POOL - VEHICLE REPLACEMENT FUND, DUVAL
9 COUNTY HEALTH DEPT - STATE ACCOUNT TO THE MOBILE
10 EQUIPMENT ACCOUNT TO PURCHASE THE AGAPE HEALTH
11 MOBILE UNIT TO ALLOW THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
12 HEALTH, DUVAL COUNTY, TO INCREASE HIV/AIDS
13 PATIENT CARE IN UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES IN
14 JACKSONVILLE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-087;
15 PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR
16 REVERTER OF FUNDS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

29 Explanation of Appropriation:

30 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$75,000.00
31 from the Motor Pool - Vehicle Replacement Fund, Duval

1 County Health Dept - State Account to the Mobile Equipment
2 Account to purchase the Agape Mobile Health Unit to allow
3 the Florida Department of Health, Duval County, to increase
4 HIV/AIDs patient care in underserved communities in
5 Jacksonville.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
7 Section 1 is to utilize funds from the Florida Department of Health,
8 Duval County ("FDOH Duval"), to purchase a mobile medical unit for
9 FDOH Duval to improve access to medical care in underserved areas of
10 the Jacksonville community for those living with HIV/AIDS. The intent
11 is to reduce the spread of HIV and to reduce viral loads of those
12 living with HIV. This medical unit will become an extension of the
13 FDOH Duval's clinical operations and will serve clients at their
14 location.

15 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated by this
16 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year
17 2023-2024.

18 **Section 4. Reverter.** Any funds remaining after purchase of
19 the mobile medical unit shall be returned to the FDOH Duval.

20 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
22 without the Mayor's signature.
