ORDINANCE 2023-503

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CALENDAR YEAR 2023 ANNUAL TAXES ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, INCLUDING ONLY THE FIFTH URBAN SERVICES DISTRICT, TO WIT: THE TOWN OF BALDWIN; STATING THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE FROM 2023 THE ROLLED-BACK RATE; AUTHORIZING ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE USE REVENUES GENERATED; PROVIDING OF THE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 1982 the City of Jacksonville entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Baldwin which established the millage rate for the Town of Baldwin as a differential of not less than 18.8% of the City of Jacksonville's General Services District's millage rate; and

20 WHEREAS, this Ordinance establishes the millage rate for the 21 Town of Baldwin in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement and 22 Chapter 200, *Florida Statutes*; now therefore

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 Section 1. Ad Valorem Tax Levy - General Services District, 25 Including Only the Fifth Urban Services District (The Town of 26 Baldwin). In accordance with Chapter 200, Florida Statutes, and the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Town 27 of Baldwin, for the year 2023 there are hereby levied upon all taxable 28 29 real and personal property located within the General Services District of the city, including only the Fifth Urban Services District 30 (the Town of Baldwin), for county purposes, ad valorem taxes expressed 31

1 in terms of mills on each dollar of assessed taxable valuation in the 2 amount of 9.5260 mills, or \$9.5260 per \$1,000 assessed taxable value.

3 Section 2. Percentage Change From the Rolled-Back Rate. The 2023 operating millage rate levied herein by the Consolidated 4 5 City of Jacksonville upon property within the General Services District of the city, including only the Fifth Urban Services District 6 7 (Town of Baldwin), represents an 13.56% increase from the 2023 rolledback rate set forth in Resolution 2023-500-A, which is the amount 8 9 agreed upon in the Interlocal Agreement between the City of 10 Jacksonville and the Town of Baldwin.

11 Section 3. Assessment and Collection. The Property 12 Appraiser of the county is authorized and directed to assess, and the 13 Tax Collector of the county is authorized and directed to collect, 14 pursuant to law, the ad valorem taxes levied in this Ordinance.

15 Section 4. Use of Revenues. The revenues raised by the ad 16 valorem taxes levied in this Ordinance shall be utilized in the manner 17 and for the purposes specified in the 2023-2024 budget and 18 appropriations ordinance.

19 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
20 effective upon signature by the Council President.
