AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ABATEMENT OF RENT FOR CERTAIN LICENSEES IN THE FLORIDA THEATRE OFFICE BUILDING FOR THE MONTHS OF JULY, AUGUST, SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER 2023 ΙN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$2,975.56; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER FIRST AMENDMENT TO THAT CERTAIN LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR FLORIDA THEATRE OFFICE BUILDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FOLLOWING LICENSEES, RESPECTIVELY: (1) CATHY REED DBA C-SUITE REALTY, (2) JACKSONVILLE DANCE THEATRE, INC. AND (3) SPEC CHECK, LLC, INCORPORATE TERMS AND CONDITIONS RELEVANT TO RENT ABATEMENT WHERE ONGOING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS OR OTHER DISRUPTIONS MAY OCCUR IN THE FLORIDA THEATRE OFFICE BUILDING THAT RENDER UNSUITABLE FOR USE AND OFFICES OCCUPANCY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Rent Abatement Authorized. The Council hereby approves and authorizes abatement of rent for the months of July,

August, September and October 2023 for Cathy Reed DBA C-Suite Realty, Jacksonville Dance Theatre, Inc. and Spec Check, LLC (collectively, the "Licensees"), in the estimated total amount of \$2,975.56. The City has scheduled necessary HVAC repairs for the Florida Theatre Office Building beginning July 1st, 2023 through October 27th, 2023 that will render the office spaces occupied by the Licensees unsuitable for use and occupancy. The City therefore desires to abate the rent for each Licensee during this period of displacement. In addition, the Council hereby authorizes future administrative rent abatements of periods of up to 180 consecutive days, subject to the terms and conditions of the Amendments authorized in Section 2 below, when abatement may become necessary due to temporary displacement of a tenant for capital repairs or improvements.

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Section 2. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, that certain First Amendment to License Agreement for Florida Theatre Office Building between the City and the following Licensees: (1) Cathy Reed DBA C-Suite Realty, (2) Jacksonville Dance Theatre, Inc. and (3) Spec Check, LLC (collectively, "Amendments"), copies of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference. The License Agreements modified by the Amendments described herein were originally authorized and approved by Ordinance 2014-92-E. Copies of said License Agreements have been placed **On File** with the Legislative Services Division. The Amendments provide the terms and conditions relevant to rent abatement where ongoing capital improvements or other disruptions at the Florida Theatre Office Building render a Licensee's office space unsuitable for use and occupancy and authorize rent abatement for periods of up to 180 consecutive days subject to the terms and conditions of the Amendments.
