Type of Action: Appropriation, agreement authorization, designation of oversight agency and CIP amendment

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$411,625.25 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management. The Modification to Subgrant Agreement, Contract Number H0337, Modification Number Four, between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida Division of Emergency Management is authorized. The Public Buildings Division of the Department of Public Works will provide oversight. The 2022-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program is amended to provide funding for the project.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the purchase and installation of a permanent generator at the Department of Health Building located at 515 West 6th Street, within Council District 7. The permanent generator will reduce and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of power outages during severe weather or other hazards.

Policy Impact Area: Department of Health Generator Replacement project

Fiscal Impact: \$411,625.25 as initiated by B.T. 23-118 in FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program grant funds
