4 **ORDINANCE 2023-610**

5 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS  
6 PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED BY ORDINANCE 2021-382-E  
7 AND SUBSEQUENTLY RE-APPROPRIATED AND CARRIED  
8 OVER IN ORDINANCE 2022-93-E; APPROVING, AND  
9 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE  
10 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN  
11 AMENDMENT TO THE GRANT AGREEMENT FOR HISTORIC  
12 STANTON SCHOOL BUILDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF  
13 JACKSONVILLE AND HISTORIC STANTON, INC. TO  
14 EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT TO EXPIRE ON  
15 SEPTEMBER 30, 2024; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY  
16 THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION;  
17 REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;  
18 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 **WHEREAS,** Ordinance 2021-382-E appropriated \$300,000 to a  
21 designated contingency account for Historic Stanton, Inc. to be used  
22 for building improvements at the historic Stanton School located at  
23 521 West Ashley Street in downtown Jacksonville; and

24 **WHEREAS,** Ordinance 2022-93-E subsequently appropriated  
25 \$156,290 from the contingency account created by Ordinance 2021-382-E  
26 and authorized execution of a Grant Agreement for Historic Stanton  
27 School Building between the City of Jacksonville and Historic Stanton,  
28 Inc. (the "Grant Agreement"), providing the terms and conditions for  
29 expenditure of City funds for completion of improvements to the  
30 Historic Stanton School for a term expiring on September 30, 2023;  
31 and

1           **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2022-93-E also authorized the carryover of  
2 the remaining \$143,710 appropriated by Ordinance 2021-382-E for  
3 improvements to the school to September 30, 2023, and these funds  
4 currently remain in the contingency account; and

5           **WHEREAS**, as of August 22, 2023, \$100,000 has been distributed  
6 to Historic Stanton, Inc. through the Grant Agreement with \$56,290  
7 remaining; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to extend the term of the  
9 Grant Agreement to September 30, 2024, and to authorize the carryover  
10 of the funds remaining in the Historic Stanton contingency account  
11 through September 30, 2024; now therefore

12           **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

13           **Section 1. Carryover.** The funding originally appropriated  
14 by Ordinance 2021-382-E and subsequently carried over into the 2022-  
15 2023 fiscal year by Ordinance 2022-93-E is hereby carried over until  
16 September 30, 2024, to remain available to Historic Stanton, Inc. for  
17 completion of improvements to the Historic Stanton School in  
18 accordance with the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement.  
19 Funding in the amount of \$56,290 will remain in its current 1Cloud  
20 account available for payment to Historic Stanton, Inc. upon  
21 successful completion of required Grant Agreement terms. The  
22 remaining \$143,710 will remain in the Historic Stanton contingency  
23 account for future appropriation.

24           **Section 2. Approval and Authorization to Execute an**  
25 **Amendment to Grant Agreement.** There is hereby approved, and the  
26 Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby  
27 authorized to execute and deliver, an amendment to the Grant Agreement  
28 to extend the term to September 30, 2024, with all other terms and  
29 conditions of the Grant Agreement remaining unchanged.

30           **Section 3. Oversight.** The Grants and Contract Compliance  
31 Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall oversee

1 the Grant Agreement described herein.

2           **Section 4.           Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**  
3 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this  
4 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the  
5 funding described herein will lapse to the General Fund Fund Balance  
6 on September 30, 2023, and the Council desires the funding remaining  
7 available for improvements to the Historic Stanton School.

8           **Section 5.           Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
9 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
10 without the Mayor's signature.
