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ORDINANCE 2023-511

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$47,593,032 (\$46,968,032 FROM SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY -KHA AND \$625,000 FROM GENERAL FUND - GSD SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY) TO THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE (KHA); PROVIDING FOR THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET TRANSFER POWERS; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS BY THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY WITH NAMED GRANT RECIPIENTS; APPROVAL AND AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH NAMED GRANT RECIPIENTS AND INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE; AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES PURSUANT TO SINGLE-SOURCE AWARD PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN SECTIONS 126.206 (SINGLE-SOURCE, NONCOMPETITIVE 126.312 (SINGLE-SOURCE PURCHASES) AND NONCOMPETITIVE PURCHASE OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE; AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES PURSUANT TO THE COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION EXEMPTIONS LISTED IN SECTION 126.107 (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE; WAIVING SECTION 77.111(A)

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(PROVIDER CONTRACTS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE; WAIVING SECTION 77.113 (ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET; BUDGET TRANSFERS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE, AND SECTION 106.304 TRANSFER POWER), CHAPTER 106 (BUDGET ACCOUNTING CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR BUDGET TRANSFERS WITHIN THE PLAN; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF GRANT AGREEMENTS AND INVOKING THE EXEMPTION ΙN SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE; AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF GENERAL COUNSEL AND THE COUNCIL AUDITOR'S OFFICE TO MAKE ALL CHANGES NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE COUNCIL'S ACTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

Explanation of Appropriation: The funding above is an (C) appropriation of \$47,593,032, consisting of \$46,968,032 from the Special Council Contingency - KHA account and \$625,000 from the General Fund - GSD Special Council

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Contingency account, to the Kids Hope Alliance for subsidies and contributions to private organizations.

Section 2. Kids Hope Alliance Comprehensive Budget Approved; Grant and Budget Transfers Authorized. The Kids Hope Alliance Fiscal Year 2023-2024 budget of \$47,593,032 for subsidies and contributions to private organizations is herein appropriated as provided on Revised Exhibit 1. Kids Hope Alliance is authorized to receive grants and make budget transfers in the manner described below:

- (a) Grants Received by Kids Hope Alliance. The Kids Hope Alliance is authorized and directed to follow the grant approval process as outlined in Section 1.3 (e)(1) & (2) in the City Budget Ordinance, 2023-504-E.
 - (b) Kids Hope Alliance Transfer Authority Within the Plan.

The Kids Hope Alliance is authorized to transfer, through a transfer directive approved by the Mayor's Budget Review Committee, appropriations within each of the Essential Services Plan Categories, and (ii) appropriations between Essential Services Plan Categories, provided that cumulative transfers out of an Essential Service Category do not exceed 25% of the individual Essential Services Category budget from which the funds are being transferred. Any transfer out of an Essential Services Category that results in more than 25% of an individual Essential Services Category budget being transferred out shall require City Council approval. In addition to the transfer authority provided in the preceding sentences of this subsection (b), the Kids Hope Alliance is authorized to transfer to any Essential Services Category, through a transfer directive approved by the Mayor's Budget Review Committee, excess funds remaining after completion or termination of a contract for children's services. Such transfers of excess funds shall not be included in the calculation of, and shall not be subject to, the 25% limitation

provided in this subsection (b). There shall be provided to the Council Auditor, the Council Finance Committee, and the Mayor's Budget Review Committee at the end of each month a report detailing all transfers made during that month.

Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Execute Agreements With Named Grant Recipients and Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. Subject to the authorization terms in Grant Agreements, the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary and/or the Chief Executive Officer of the Kids Hope Alliance ("CEO") are hereby authorized to contract directly with the entities listed in the grant awards for the Criminal Justice Reinvestment, Department of Health & Human Services (SAMHSA), and Department of Justice grants, as shown in Revised Schedule M attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference, and to extend or renew such contracts to the extent that the underlying is extended or renewed. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such services are exempted from competitive solicitation because the services to be provided are being approved pursuant to this Ordinance.

Section 4. Authorization to Procure Services Pursuant to the Single-Source Award Provisions Contained in Section 126.206 and Section 126.312, Ordinance Code. Kids Hope Alliance is authorized to procure supplies, professional services and contractual services, including but not limited to, children and youth services pursuant to the single-source award provisions contained in Section 126.206 (Single-source, noncompetitive purchases) and Section 126.312 (Single-source noncompetitive purchase of professional services), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, as needed. All such services procured by Kids Hope Alliance pursuant to Sections 126.206 and 126.312, Ordinance Code, shall be consistent with the purposes

of Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Ordinance Code, and awarded in accordance with Chapter 126, Ordinance Code.

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Section 5. Authorization to Procure Services Pursuant to the Competitive Solicitation Exemptions Contained in Section 126.107, Ordinance Code. Kids Hope Alliance is authorized to procure supplies, professional services and contractual services, including but not limited to, children and youth services pursuant to the competitive solicitation exemptions listed in Section 126.107 (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, as needed. All such services procured by Kids Hope Alliance pursuant to Section 126.107, Ordinance Code, shall be consistent with the purposes of Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Ordinance Code, and awarded in accordance with Chapter 126, Ordinance Code.

Section 6. Waiving Section 77.111(a), Ordinance Code. City hereby waives the provisions in Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Ordinance Code, with respect to the authorizations described in Sections 3 through 5 above and Section 8 below. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services to be competitively procured by Kids Hope Alliance via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is necessary to allow Kids Hope Alliance to: (i) enter into direct contracts with the entities described in Section 3 above and Section 8 below; (ii) procure supplies, professional services and contractual services, including but not limited to, children and youth services pursuant to the single-source award provisions contained in Sections 126.206 and 126.312, Ordinance Code, as needed, as described in Section 4 above; and (iii) procure supplies, professional services and contractual services, including but not limited to, children and youth services pursuant to the competitive solicitation exemptions contained in Section 126.107, Ordinance Code, as needed, as described in Section 5 above.

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Section 7. Waiving Section 77.113 and Section 106.304, Section 77.113 (Annual operating budget; budget Ordinance Code. transfers), Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Ordinance Code, regarding the Kids Hope Alliance budget transfer authority, and Section 106.304 (Mayor's transfer power), Subpart Α Provisions), Part 3 (Appropriations), Chapter 106 Accounting Code), Ordinance Code, regarding the Mayor's transfer authority, are hereby waived. The provisions for Kids Hope Alliance budget transfers are permitted by compliance with Section 2(b) of this Ordinance.

Section 8. Approval and Authorization to Execute Grant Agreements and Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code.

Approval and authorization to execute grant agreements. Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary and/or Chief Executive Officer of the Kids Hope Alliance ("CEO") are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute grant agreements and to disburse grant funds to the following entities, in the notto-exceed amounts outlined below, and for the programs described herein as follows: (1) \$150,000 to the Police Athletic League of Jacksonville, Incorporated for its Teen Leadership Program as described in **Exhibit 3**, attached hereto; (2) \$150,000 to Operation Save Our Sons, Inc. for the Operation Save Our Sons Program as described in **Exhibit 4**, attached hereto; (3) \$125,000 to Northeast Florida Healthy Start Coalition, Inc. for the Safe Sleep Initiative as described in **Exhibit 5**, attached hereto; (4) \$75,000 to My Village Project, Inc. for Project Daily Attendance as described in **Exhibit 6**, attached hereto; (5) \$50,000 to Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. - Upsilon Lambda Chapter for Youth Development Programs as described in Exhibit 7, attached hereto; and (6) \$75,000 to The Giving Closet Project, Inc. for its

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Essential Angels Program as described in Exhibit 8, attached hereto. These grants shall be subject to and administered in accordance with Chapter 77, Ordinance Code, and the terms, scope and conditions more fully described in the above-enumerated Exhibits and the grant agreements entered into between the City and/or KHA and the respective recipient agencies.

Invoking the exemption in Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City and/or KHA are authorized to enter into grant agreements with the entities listed in Section 8(a) above for the services outlined in the Exhibit attached hereto for each respective recipient. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 9. Office of General Counsel and Council Auditor's Office Authorization. The Office of General Counsel and the Council Auditor's Office are hereby authorized to make all changes to titles, tables of content, Ordinance Code, journal entries, schedules, attachments, editorial and text changes consistent with the changes set forth herein to Ordinance 2023-504 and Ordinance 2023-511 to effectuate the Council's action.

Section 10. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
