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ORDINANCE 2023-561-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE OR HER DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION MAYOR, SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A FIRST AMENDMENT ("AMENDMENT") TO GRANT AGREEMENT ("AGREEMENT") BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND MAYPORT WATERFRONT, INC. ("RECIPIENT") TO: (1) EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2024; (2) AMEND THE SCOPE OF SERVICES TO INCREASE THE PROJECTED NUMBER OF FUNDRAISING EVENTS AND THE FUNDRAISING GOAL; (3) AUTHORIZE TWO ADVANCE PAYMENTS FOR THE REMAINING BALANCE OF GRANT FUNDS TO RECIPIENT, THE FIRST IN THE AMOUNT OF \$62,000 DUE ON OCTOBER 30, 2023, AND THE SECOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$36,000 DUE ON 31, 2024; AND (4)CERTAIN JANUARY AMENDMENTS AS SET FORTH IN THE AMENDMENT AUTHORIZED HEREBY; WAIVING SECTION 118.201(F)(7) (RELEASE OF APPROPRIATIONS), PART 2 (DISBURSEMENT OF CITY GRANTS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR ADVANCE PAYMENTS TO THE RECIPIENT; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC

DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City and Mayport Waterfront, Inc. ("Recipient"), previously entered into that certain FY 2022-2023 City Grant Agreement dated October 1, 2022, as authorized by Ordinance 2022-504-E (the "Agreement") to provide a grant from the City to Recipient in the amount of \$140,000 to be used to develop an economic development revitalization and implementation plan (the "Plan") for Mayport Village; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement included certain fundraising goals for Recipient, as well as procurement of the Plan, and Recipient has requested to extend the initial term of the Agreement for an additional one-year period, to September 30, 2024, in order to further its fundraising goals and complete the Plan and other associated deliverables; and

WHEREAS, Recipient has requested the City to enter into a First Amendment to Grant Agreement substantially in the form place Revised On File with the Legislative Services Division; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Amendment to Grant Agreement approved. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor or her designee and Corporation Secretary are authorized to enter into a First Amendment to Grant Agreement ("Amendment") between the City and the Recipient, substantially in the form placed Revised On File with the Legislative Services Division. The Amendment extends the expiration of the term of the Agreement from September 30, 2023 to September 30, 2024, amends the scope of services to reflect the same, increases the projected number of fundraising events and raises the fundraising goal, and authorizes two advance payments of the remaining balance of grant funds, \$62,000 on or about October 30, 2023, and \$36,000 on or about January 31, 2024, and makes certain

other amendments as set forth in the Amendment, with all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remaining unchanged.

Section 2. Waiving Section 118.201(f)(7), Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.201(f)(7) (Release of Appropriations), Part 2 (Disbursement of City Grants), Chapter 118 (City Grants), are hereby waived to allow for advance payments to Recipient as set forth in Section 1. This waiver is justified in that it will allow the Recipient, a volunteer-based and community-led organization that does not have the finances to support reimbursement-based payments, to continue its outreach and revitalization efforts for Mayport Village.

Section 3. Oversight Department. The OED shall oversee the Agreement as amended hereby.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
