Bill Summary: The bill adopts the 2023 Assessment Report for the City's 2045 Comprehensive Plan and authorizes the Planning and Development Department to provide a written response to the State Land Planning Agency regarding the City's proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan.

Background Information: Pursuant to state law, at least once every 7 years, local governments are required to evaluate their comprehensive plans to determine if plan amendments are necessary to reflect the minimum planning period of at least 10 years or to reflect changes in state requirements since the last update of the plan. Local governments are also required to notify the State Land Planning Agency of the results of the evaluation. Jacksonville's notification to the state is due by November 1, 2023.

The proposed amendments to the *Comp Plan* include updates to population growth projections; provisions regarding affordable workforce housing; provisions regarding floating solar facilities; a revision regarding school concurrency; and revisions regarding wastewater treatment and pollutant loads.
