Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Monique L. Thompson as a member of the Jacksonville Small and Emerging Business "JSEB" Monitoring Committee, as a private citizen, replacing Kimano Edwards, for a first full term to expire on April 30, 2026.

(Note: needs to be amended in committee, the name of the person being replaced is incorrect as Mr. Edwards is a Council appointed member, and the term would need to adjust accordingly)

Background Information: The JSEB Monitoring Committee is established pursuant to Section 126.607, *Ordinance Code*, and charged with reviewing the status and achievements of the JSEB Program Goals.

Section 126.607 (b), *Ordinance Code*, provides that three of the members of the JSEB Monitoring Committee are appointed by the Mayor, and confirmed by Council, including a private citizen.

Ms. Thompson holds a bachelor's degree from Grambling State University and a master's degree in accountancy from the University of Phoenix. She is the president of Custom Strategic Solutions LLC. and worked previously as the Director of Audit and Compliance for JTA. Ms. Tompson resides in Duval County is council district 9.
