8 **ORDINANCE 2023-559-E**

9 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,458,000.00 FROM  
10 THE MOBILITY FEE - ZONE 2 BIKE PED-ACTIVITY TO  
11 THE UNF CAMPUS BICYCLE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO  
12 FUND THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW  
13 SHARED-USE BIKE AND PEDESTRIAN PATH, AS  
14 INITIATED BY B.T. 23-111; PURPOSE OF  
15 APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR  
16 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY  
17 ORDINANCE 2022-505-E TO REFLECT THIS  
18 APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
19 DATE.

21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
23 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
24 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
25 listed in subsection (b):

1 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

2 The funding above is an appropriation of funds from  
3 Mobility Fee - Zone 2 Bike Ped-Activity to the UNF Campus  
4 Bicycle Improvements project to provide funding for the  
5 design and construction of a multi-use bike pedestrian path  
6 (the "Project").

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
8 Section 1 is to provide funding for the design and construction of  
9 the Project. These funds will cover related costs for design and  
10 construction of a multi-use bicycle and pedestrian path with bicycle  
11 pavement markings and signage for segments of UNF Drive. The specific  
12 portions are UNF West from 9A to UNF East and UNF East from UNF West  
13 to Kernan Boulevard.

14 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2022-505-E, being the  
15 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and  
16 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide  
17 additional funding for the Project. The project is more fully  
18 described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Revised**  
19 **Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP Sheet, September  
20 18, 2023 - NCSPHS", and incorporated herein by this reference. The  
21 Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until  
22 the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best  
23 interests of the community because such deferral will result in  
24 unnecessary delay of the Project which will provide pedestrian safety.

25 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of  
26 this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
27 Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment  
28 set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an  
29 amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-  
30 Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E  
31 shall continue in full force and effect.

1           **Section 4.           Effective Date.**   This Ordinance shall become  
2 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
3 without the Mayor's signature.
