The Company is looking to expand its manufacturing operations and is considering leasing an existing building on the westside of Jacksonville. This expansion of operations will look to continue operations in its current location and increase production of its product at a new location. Currently, the Company is considering options in other parts of Florida and other states to increase production volumes. The Company plans to expand into an existing building with a capital investment exceeding \$20 million and an additional \$8.775 million in equipment.
