Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Anna Brosche as the Director of Finance and

Chief Financial Officer for the City of Jacksonville.

Background Information: Per Sec. 24.01(c), *Jacksonville Charter*, the Director of the Finance Department shall have a bachelor's degree from an accredited post-secondary institution in finance, accounting, business administration, public administration, or a similar field, and seven (7) years' experience in public or governmental finance, three of which are in a management capacity, and a thorough understanding of the principals of municipal finance, budgeting, and accounting, and of applicable provisions of the Laws of the State of Florida; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Ms. Brosche holds a bachelor's degree in business administration and a master's degree in accountancy from the University of North Florida, and she is a certified public accountant. Ms. Brosche has been a relationship partner for BDO USA LLP since 2019 and prior to that was a managing shareholder for Ennis, Pellum & Associates, CPAs for 17 years. She served as an at-large member of City Council from 2015-2019 during which time she was chair of the Finance Committee in 2016 and was elected Council President in 2017. Ms. Brosche resides in Duval County in council district 5.
