5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$231,758.00 IN GRANT  
6 FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF  
7 TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") TO PROVIDE  
8 REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE FOR  
9 THE FUNDING OF CONSTRUCTION AND CONSTRUCTION  
10 OVERSIGHT OF THE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS  
11 ON PARK STREET AND MARGARET STREET FROM  
12 RIVERSIDE AVENUE TO THE INTERSTATE-95 RAMPS (THE  
13 "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-012; PURPOSE  
14 OF APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2024-2028 FIVE-  
15 YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY  
16 ORDINANCE 2023-505-E TO REFLECT THIS  
17 APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT  
18 BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, ENGINEERING  
19 AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION; PROVIDING  
20 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,  
24 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
25 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents a grant from the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for reimbursement of the City's costs related to construction and construction oversight of installation of pedestrian safety improvements on Park Street and Margaret Street from Riverside Avenue to the Interstate-95 ramps including the addition of raised crosswalks, the upgrade of existing crosswalks, and re-timing signal controls (the "Project").

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to receive and allocate FDOT's funding for the Project. A copy of the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Standard Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the State of Florida Department of Transportation (Contract Number: G2888) providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services (the "Agreement").

**Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to this reallocation of funds from the Prior Projects to the Projects as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral could result in loss of grant funding for the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP

1 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute  
2 an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the  
3 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E  
4 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

5 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Department of Public Works shall  
6 oversee the Project and the Agreement described herein.

7 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
8 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
9 without the Mayor's signature.
