AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$284,000.00 FROM THE MAYOR'S TASK FORCE CONTINGENCY TO THE SPECIAL EVENTS - MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. ACTIVITIES BUDGET TO SUPPORT THE MLK WEEK OF PROGRAMMING TO BE HELD JANUARY 13, 2024 THROUGH JANUARY 20, 2024, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-016; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
