

FINANCE AMENDMENT #3

The Finance Committee offers the following third amendment to File No. 2023-807:

- (1) On **page 1, line 30 and page 9, line 10**, after "Access," **insert** "of which at least ten percent (\$100,000) shall be set aside specifically for Jacksonville Small and Emerging Businesses ("JSEBs") taking part in the program,";
- (2) On **page 2, lines 14-15 and page 8, lines 4, 7 and 9**, **strike** "Revised B.T. 24-023" and **insert** "Fourth Revised B.T. 24-023";
- (3) On **page 7, line 16**, **strike** "Revised On File" and **insert** "Fourth Revised On File";
- (4) On **page 8, line 4**, **strike** "Revised Exhibit 1" and **insert** "Fourth Revised Exhibit 1, labeled as "Fourth Revised Exhibit 1, 4th Rev B.T. 24-023, December 5, 2023 - Finance"";
- (5) On **page 8, lines 7 and 9**, **strike** "attached";
- (6) Remove **Revised Exhibit 1** and replace with **Fourth Revised Exhibit 1**, attached hereto, which attaches the fourth revised B.T. 24-023 to reflect that \$100,000 for the Small Business Capital Access program will be for micro-grants and low-interest loans for JSEBs;
- (7) Remove **Revised On File** and replace with **Fourth Revised On File**, attached hereto, which attaches the fourth revised Mayor's Task Force Programs and Initiatives Summary to reflect that a minimum of ten percent (\$100,000) of the funding for the Small Business Capital Access program will be allocated for micro-grants and low-interest loans for JSEBs;
- (8) On **page 1, line 1**, amend the introductory sentence to add that

the bill was amended as reflected herein.
