

## Terms and Scope of Services

**Recipient:** Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville, Inc. (“Cultural Council”)

**City Funding Request:** \$180,000

**Fiscal Year:** Fiscal Year 2023-2024

**City Contract Term:** Effective Date of Ordinance – September 30, 2024

### **Background/Purpose:**

The creation and installation of public art projects which align with the identity of the neighborhood and the telling of the stories of our diverse communities through art is vital to deepening our civic pride. Artist(s) must reside in CPAC district where project will be installed/displayed.

### **Scope of Work:**

Funding will be used to:

- Support public art projects by local artists in coordination with each of the City’s six CPAC districts (\$25,000 per district); and
- Develop timeline for opening process from submission through selection and installation.

Artists selected will live in the district where their art, which will celebrate the unique culture and history of that area, will be installed. Each CPAC will have a \$25,000 budget to execute. \$15,000 shall be utilized by the Cultural Council for both Administration and Maintenance, respectively.

### **Payment Terms:**

Payment shall be made on a draw or reimbursable basis.

### **Additional Grant Requirements and Restrictions:**

City Funds for the program shall be subject to Chapter 118, Part 6, Subpart B (Art in Public Places), Jacksonville Municipal Code, as applicable.
