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17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
19 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
21 listed in subsection (b):

29 The funding above represents an appropriation of funds from
30 the Jacksonville Upward Mobility Program - Contingency to
31 the Jacksonville Upward Mobility Program - Trust Fund

1 Authorized Expenditures. The Jacksonville Upward Mobility
2 Program Special Revenue Fund (the "Fund"), established in
3 Section 111.630, *Ordinance Code*, is a permanent special
4 revenue fund into which the City annually deposits an
5 amount equal to 1% of the approved economic development
6 agreement monetary commitments by the City to developers
7 during a calendar year for inclusion in the next annual
8 budget.

9 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
10 Section 1 is to provide funding to the Jacksonville Upward Mobility
11 Program to build the capacity of existing programs and/or create new
12 programs geared towards the training, education, and maintenance of
13 a sustainable local workforce, consistent with Section 180.103,
14 *Ordinance Code*.

15 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
17 without the Mayor's signature.
