5 **ORDINANCE 2023-872-E**

6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM THE
7 TRAFFIC CALMING - DISTRICT 1 OTHER CONSTRUCTION
8 COSTS ACCOUNT TO THE COUNCIL DISTRICT 1
9 CONTRACTUAL SERVICES ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING
10 TO ADDRESS VARIOUS BLIGHT AND SAFETY CONCERNS IN
11 COUNCIL DISTRICT 1; AMENDING THE 2024-2028 FIVE-
12 YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY
13 ORDINANCE 2023-505-E TO REFLECT REMOVAL OF THE
14 TRAFFIC CALMING - DISTRICT 1 PROJECT; REQUESTING
15 ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN
16 EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

30 The funding above represents an appropriation of
31 \$100,000.00 from the Traffic Calming - District 1 Other

1 Construction Costs account to the Council District 1
2 Contractual Services account to provide funding to address
3 blight and safety concerns in Council District 1.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
5 Section 1 is to reallocate funding originally set aside for traffic
6 calming in Council District 1 to fund contractual services related
7 to tree trimming, beautification, landscaping enhancements and
8 traffic calming to address a broader range of blight and safety
9 concerns in Council District 1.

10 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
11 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
12 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
13 hereby amended to reflect removal of the Traffic Calming - District
14 1 Project (the "Project") as reflected in the Project Information
15 Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
16 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment
17 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be
18 detrimental to the best interests of the community because there is
19 an immediate need to reallocate the Project funds to address blight
20 and safety concerns raised by the community in Council District 1.

21 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
22 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
23 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
24 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
25 an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the
26 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E
27 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

28 **Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
29 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this
30 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that there
31 is an immediate need to reallocate these funds for contractual

1 services to address ongoing blight and safety concerns in Council
2 District 1.

3 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
4 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
5 without the Mayor's signature.
