5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$66,000.00 IN GRANT
6 FUNDING FROM THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY
7 ADMINISTRATION ("NHTSA") FUNDED THROUGH THE FY
8 23-24 STATE AND COMMUNITY HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY
9 PROGRAM, THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
10 TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT"), TO THE PSBU
11 GRANTS/OCCUPANT PROTECTION PROJECT FY24 TO
12 INCREASE SAFETY BELT USE, AS INITIATED BY B.T.
13 24-052; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR
14 HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO
15 EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE
16 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY") THAT CERTAIN
17 STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
18 (FDOT) SUBGRANT FOR HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY FUNDS
19 NUMBER G2S39 BETWEEN THE CITY AND FDOT;
20 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE
21 SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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23 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
25 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
26 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
27 listed in subsection (b):

3 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

4 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
5 funds from the National Highway Traffic Safety
6 Administration ("NHTSA") funded through the FY 23-24 State
7 and Community Highway Traffic Safety Program, through the
8 Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to the PSBU
9 Grants/Occupant Protection Project FY24 to perform
10 overtime operations to increase safety belt use. No local
11 match is required.

12 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
13 Section 1 is to utilize grant funding to perform High-Visibility
14 Enforcement (HVE) operations in high-frequency crash areas that
15 target occupant protection by increasing safety belt use and will
16 cover expenses for overtime and certain related benefits for law
17 enforcement officers. The term of the grant, and period of
18 performance, shall begin upon the City and FDOT's execution of
19 that certain State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT)
20 Subgrant for Highway Traffic Safety Funds Number G2S39 between the
21 City and FDOT (the "Grant Agreement"), and shall end on September
22 30, 2024. The Grant Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions
23 of the grant.

24 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Execute**
25 **Agreements.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her
26 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to
27 execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Grant
28 Agreement in substantially the same form as placed **On File** with
29 the Office of Legislative Services, and any respective extensions
30 or amendments thereto as necessary and appropriate to effectuate
31 the intent of this Ordinance.

1 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
2 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described
3 herein.

4 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
