5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$400,000 FROM GENERAL
6 FUND OPERATING RESERVES TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL
7 FUNDING FOR THE HOME ROOF INITIATIVE DESCRIBED
8 AND APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2023-807-E; PROVIDING
9 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT,
10 HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIVISION;
11 REQUESTING ONE-CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;
12 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
16 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
17 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
18 listed in subsection (b):

25 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

26 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$400,000
27 from General Fund Operating Reserves to provide additional
28 funding to the Miscellaneous Grants and Aids budget for
29 the Home Roof Initiative described in and approved by
30 Ordinance 2023-807-E.

31 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in

1 Section 1 is to provide additional funding for the Home Roof
2 Initiative originally approved by Ordinance 2023-807-E. This
3 Initiative was created based on recommendations from the Mayoral
4 Transition Committees and a series of community conversations as one
5 of several programs that could assist in addressing homelessness or
6 homelessness prevention in Jacksonville. This Initiative provides
7 funding in a maximum amount of up to \$14,999 to qualified households
8 in Duval County in need of a roof replacement to avoid loss of
9 insurance coverage.

10 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Neighborhoods Department,
11 Housing and Community Development Division, shall have oversight of
12 the project described herein.

13 **Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
14 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this
15 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that there
16 are currently a large number of qualified households on a waiting
17 list to receive assistance through this Initiative. This additional
18 funding will allow the City to provide assistance to a greater number
19 of households as quickly as possible, prior to the upcoming storm
20 season.

21 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
23 without the Mayor's signature.
