5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE  
6 MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
7 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON  
8 BEHALF OF THE CITY, A ROADWAY JURISDICTION  
9 TRANSFER (RJT) AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF  
10 JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT  
11 OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") TRANSFERRING FROM THE  
12 STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO THE CITY A PORTION OF  
13 THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY KNOWN AS RIVERSIDE AVENUE  
14 (ROADWAY ID 72050000), STATE ROAD 211 ON RAMP  
15 FROM JEFFERSON STREET (ROADWAY ID 72050447), AND  
16 SR 13 ACOSTA BRIDGE CONNECTOR (ROADWAY ID  
17 72160448) (COLLECTIVELY, THE "ROADWAYS")  
18 INCLUDING THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE OPERATION,  
19 MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR OF THE ROADWAYS AND  
20 PROVIDING FOR RECORDING OF RIGHT-OF-WAY MAPS IN  
21 THE PUBLIC LAND RECORDS BY THE CITY; PROVIDING  
22 FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND  
23 CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE  
24 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN  
25 EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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27 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

28 **Section 1. Roadway Jurisdiction Transfer Agreement**  
29 **Approved.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her  
30 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to  
31 execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City of Jacksonville,

1 the Roadway Jurisdiction Transfer (RJT) Agreement between Florida  
2 Department of Transportation ("FDOT") and the City of Jacksonville  
3 ("City"), in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit**  
4 **1** and incorporated herein by reference (the "Agreement"). FDOT owns  
5 certain rights-of-way located within the corporate limits of the City  
6 and known as Riverside Avenue (Roadway ID 72050000) commencing at  
7 milepost 7.428 and extending to milepost 7.699, State Road 211 On  
8 Ramp from Jefferson Street (Roadway ID 72050447) commencing at  
9 milepost 0.000 and extending to milepost 0.188, and SR 13 Acosta  
10 Bridge Connector (Roadway ID 72160448) commencing at milepost 0.900  
11 and extending to milepost 1.111, (collectively, the "Roadways"), all  
12 as more particularly shown on the location map attached to the  
13 Agreement as Exhibit A. The Agreement transfers from the State  
14 Highway System to the City of Jacksonville the Roadways and the  
15 responsibility for the operation, maintenance, and repair of the  
16 Roadways, including the actual roadbed, together with the right-of-  
17 way and all bridges, curbs, culverts, drainage structures, sidewalks,  
18 bike paths, and other ways located within the Roadways. Upon  
19 completion of the transfer, the City shall own, operate, maintain,  
20 and repair the Roadways and all improvements therein. The Agreement  
21 also provides for transfer of the Roadways by right-of-way map  
22 transfer to be recorded in the public land records by the City.

23 **Section 2. Oversight Department.** The Engineering and  
24 Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works  
25 shall have oversight with respect to the Agreement and project  
26 described herein.

27 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
29 without the Mayor's signature.
