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ORDINANCE 2024-119

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COUNCIL RULES; AMENDING COUNCIL RULE 4.601 (MAJORITY ACTION), CHAPTER 4 (PROCEDURES), PART 6 (VOTING), COUNCIL RULES, TO PROVIDE THAT A TIE VOTE ON A QUASI-JUDICIAL MATTER DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A DENIAL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2023, quasi-judicial Ordinance 2023-007
was filed with Council to consider a request to rezone property
located at 1004 Hendricks Avenue, 1454 and 0 Prudential Drive and 0
Home Street in the Southbank area of Downtown Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, after numerous public hearings and deferrals at the Council's Land Use and Zoning Committee, Ordinance 2023-007 was considered by the full Council for final action on June 27, 2023; and

20 WHEREAS, at the final meeting the Council's vote on Ordinance 21 2023-007 was a 9-9 tie vote; and

WHEREAS, Council Rule 4.601 requires a "majority vote" by the voting Council members in order to take affirmative action on all legislation; and

WHEREAS, an interpretation of the 9-9 tie vote on Ordinance 26 2023-007, in conjunction with the "majority vote" language of Council 27 Rule 4.601, resulted in a denial of Ordinance 2023-007 because of its 28 failure to obtain a majority vote in support of the rezoning request; 29 and

30 WHEREAS, the applicant challenged the Council's action, 31 resulting in a desire to clarify the voting requirements for 1 affirmative action by the Council on quasi-judicial matters before 2 the Council; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Council Rule 4.601 (Majority Action),
Chapter 4 (Procedures), Part 6 (Voting), Council Rules. Rule 4.601
(Majority Action), Chapter 4 (Procedures), Part 6 (Voting), Council *Rules*, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 4. PROCEDURES

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PART 6. VOTING

11 RULE 4.601 MAJORITY ACTION

12 Unless otherwise required by the Chartercharter or ordinances of the City or indicated by these Rules, all action by the Council 13 shall be by majority vote of Council Members present, who have not 14 abstained pursuant to Rule 4.602. A majority vote of all Council 15 Members (10) shall be necessary to approve and adopt each annual 16 17 budget required by the Charter to be submitted to the Council, or any item thereof, or to adopt or pass any motion or other action 18 appropriating or authorizing the expenditure of money. For quasi-19 20 judicial matters, a tie vote of all Council members present and voting shall not constitute a denial of the subject application. In the 21 22 event of a tie vote on a quasi-judicial matter, the Council may move 23 to reconsider the item for the purpose of moving and acting on an 24 alternate motion, rerefer the item back to the appropriate committee 25 of reference for additional consideration, or take any other action 26 authorized by these Rules or applicable law.

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Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
